Subject: Thrift Savings Plan Booklet *TSP at a Glance*

The Federal Retirement Thrift Investment Board has revised the booklet *TSP at a Glance*. A copy of the revised booklet is available from the “Forms & Publications” section of the Thrift Savings Plan (TSP) Web site at www.tsp.gov. Agencies may also order copies of this booklet by following the instructions contained in TSP Bulletin 95-1, dated January 3, 1995.

Designed to introduce new or newly eligible employees to the TSP and to provide a quick reference, the booklet outlines the major features of the TSP and refers employees to the *Summary of the Thrift Savings Plan for Federal Employees* for more details.

Agency responsibilities. Agencies should provide the *TSP at a Glance* to newly eligible employees, i.e., new FERS employees.* Also, agencies should provide the booklet to employees upon request and may distribute the booklet during TSP briefings. The booklet is updated periodically, and the latest version is always on the TSP Web site.
