Subject: Thrift Savings Plan Fact Sheet “Using the TSP Web Site and the ThriftLine”

The Federal Retirement Thrift Investment Board has revised the Thrift Savings Plan (TSP) Fact Sheet “Using the TSP Web Site and the ThriftLine.” A copy of the revised Fact Sheet is available from the “Forms & Publications” section of the TSP Web site at www.tsp.gov.

The Fact Sheet explains the features of the TSP Web site and the ThriftLine. Although both media allow participants to obtain information about their accounts and to request contribution allocations and interfund transfers, the Web site also provides participants a wealth of TSP information, TSP forms and publications, and interactive calculators. In addition, the Web site provides agency representatives with TSP information, including the current TSP bulletins.

Agency responsibilities. Agencies should provide a copy of this Fact Sheet to employees upon request. Agencies are also encouraged to provide the Fact Sheet to employees when they request Form TSP-50, Investment Allocation (which is the paper form employees may use to request contribution allocations or interfund transfers). The latest version of this Fact Sheet will always be available from the TSP Web site and agencies may download and reproduce it locally.
